

NOTICE OF UPCOMING ASPHALT RESURFACING WORK:

The City of Monroe has awarded a resurfacing contract to Lynch River Contracting, Inc. of Pageland, South Carolina for the repair of several streets within the City. The following is a list of streets to be resurfaced:

- Fowler Secrest Road from James Hamilton Rd to Meadowood Ct
- Patton Avenue from Charlotte Avenue to Secrest Short Cut Rd
- Hasty Street from Secrest Ave to Mullin St
- Quarry Road from Sutherland Ave to End
- Temple Street from US 74 to Euclid St
- Union Power Way from Rocky River Rd to End
- Venus Street from previous resurfacing to Quarry Rd
- Winterberry Lane – entire length off of Breckonridge Centre Dr
- Rosa Drive – entire length off Lakeview Dr
- Fox Hunt Drive from Hunt Club Ave to Hunter Davis Ct

Work is scheduled to begin on November 7, 2016 on Patton Avenue. The roadway repairs will include various types of work including milling, full depth patching, and reclamation with cement on some streets prior to final resurfacing. All streets will remain open throughout the repairs but will be narrowed to one lane of traffic at times. Access will be maintained to property owners and businesses within the immediate work area. Motorists are encouraged to avoid these areas during construction and take alternate routes when possible. All work will progress as weather allows and will be completed by the beginning of June 2017. All work on any street initiated this calendar year should be completed by December of 2016. Any streets remaining will be
