We Welcome Your Children

As a benefit for our members, MAFC offers complimentary childcare for up to two hours while you workout in our facility. Children must be active MAFC members and parent must remain on-site during your child's stay.



Procedures

Parent/Guardian must sign each child in/out. Please present your child's membership card and tape a name tag on your child's back upon check-in. If another person will be picking up your child, please let the staff know at check-in. (They must be at least 18 years old with photo ID.) Make our staff aware of any allergies your child has. Please label all belongings, and do not bring valuables. MAFC is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property.



Guidelines

Parents are responsible for providing diapers (no cloth diapers), wipes, pacifiers, prepared bottles, juice cups with lids, snacks, and drinks. Peanuts or any nut related products are not permitted in childcare rooms.

For security purposes, parents and others are not permitted to enter the rooms to play with children while in our care.

If a child becomes upset and continues to cry for more than a reasonable amount of time, staff will locate the parent within the facility. We will make every attempt to make the child feel comfortable prior to this.



Health & Behavior

We strive to promote a healthy environment for your children. Please do not bring your child if they are not feeling well. Children should be symptom free for 24 hours prior to using childcare at MAFC. Parents will be notified if their child becomes ill or starts running a fever while in our care. Children who display these symptoms of illness will not be permitted to use childcare: fever exceeding 99 degrees, colored discharge from their nose or ears, skin rashes or infectious drainage, diarrhea, vomiting. MAFC staff will not dispense any type of medication.

Children are expected to follow staff instructions. Biting, hitting, and other aggressive actions will not be tolerated. Staff will work with children to prevent such behavior, but parents will be notified if behavior becomes a problem.
