06.01 GENERAL

1. All planting of street trees shall be in accordance with the American Standard for Nursery Stock, latest edition and shall be positioned in accordance with Details 02.01.03, 02.01.04 and 02.01.07.
2. Refer to Details 06.01.01, 06.01.02 and 06.02.01 for additional tree planting standards.
