



**Belk Tonawanda Park Splash Pad Rules and Regulations**

**HOURS: 10:00 am – 7:00 pm Daily**

CLOSED FOR MAINTENANCE ON MONDAYS

**NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY**

1. The splash pad is open on a first come, first serve basis and is offered at no charge.
2. The City of Monroe is not liable from injuries resulting from unsafe or improper use.
3. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older. Parents are responsible for the supervision of their child at all times.
4. No running, horseplay, abusive language is permitted. Individuals engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior will be asked to leave the splash pad.
5. The splash pad uses treated, re-circulated water. Do NOT drink the water.
6. Do not change diapers on or near the splash pad. Changing stations are located in the restrooms. All non-toilet trained children are required to wear a swim diaper.
7. Food and drinks are not allowed within the splash pad area.
8. No alcohol, illegal substances, amplified music or weapons allowed.
9. No glass, bikes, scooters, skateboards, rollerblades or chairs are allowed in the splash pad play area.
10. Proper swimwear attire must be worn at all times. Street shoes are prohibited. Sandals, water shoes, flip flops or appropriate deck wear is recommended.
11. Do not hang, swing, or pull on the splash pad equipment. Do not block drains.
12. Please move to a safe place away from the pad at the first sign of thunder or lightning. Please wait 30 minutes after a thunder or lightning event to utilize the splash pad.
13. Pets, toys, water balloons, beach balls, pool noodles, cups, buckets and water guns are not permitted inside the splash pad play area.
14. No bathing, soap, detergent or shampoo allowed.
15. Use of the splash pad while ill with a contagious disease is prohibited. Individuals with open sores or who are sick should not enter the splash pad area.
16. No outside vendors such as concession carts, mobile food or drink, ice cream/sno cone vehicles or tents or any other outside vendor will not be permitted.
17. The splash pad may be closed at any time due to weather, maintenance or operational requirements.
18. The City of Monroe reserves the right to remove anyone violating rules or unacceptable behavior.
