All submissions due by June 30 at 5 p.m.

RULES

1. Photos must be the photographer's own photo.
2. Photos must be in Monroe's Historic District (see attached boundary map). Please include the address of the property so staff can confirm the property is in the district. Photos that are not within the district will not be posted.
3. Photos must be at least 2550 x 3300 pixels. This is a 8.5 x 11 image at 300 dpi.
4. Photos must be a .jpeg file type.
5. When photos are submitted, the participant agrees they have submitted voluntarily and will not be compensated for their photo. Photos will be posted on the City's Facebook page. The top twelve (12) photos with the most likes will be featured in the Historic District Calendar. Credit will be given to the photographer in the calendar.
