

# LOOSE LEAF COLLECTION GUIDE NOV - FEB

## GUIDELINES



Pile your leaves **behind the curb** and not in the street.



Do not bag leaves for loose leaf collection.



Do not block bike lanes, sidewalks, fire hydrants, mailboxes, storm drains, or water meters. Do not put leaves near parked cars. Leaves will **NOT** be removed until they are clear.



Make sure that your leaf piles have no tree limbs or yard debris - those need to go in a yard trimmings collection cart. Pine straw is acceptable.

**2**

Put your leaf piles behind your curb within two weeks of leaf collection crews coming to your neighborhood. The timeframe is subject to change due to weather or large volume.
