



What to expect

Once you enter into the Monroe Science Center, you are welcome to explore on your own. Staff is always available to explain an exhibit or answer any of your questions.

Exhibits are designed to be hands on for adults to learn and play side by side. We also have a sensory room and nursing room available.

All children under 14 must be with an adult at all times for their safety. If you have a large group, we enforce a 1:10 ratio of adults (16+) to children and children must be chaperoned at all times.
